Mission: The Oglethorpe University Food Pantry was created to strengthen food security at no charge to students. The food pantry will open at the Turner Lynch Campus Center in Fall 2021.

Who we serve:

- Every Oglethorpe student who is in at least one for-credit class.
- Oglethorpe students living off campus, students needing religious accommodations, and students who frequently miss regular cafeteria hours due to sports commitments.

What foods will be available:

- The food pantry will provide a variety of foods, much of which will be determined through the food preference forms.
- Food options will range from perishable meals donated from Aramark, foods with long shelf lives like dried pasta, and more.

How to use the service:

- Submit a food preference form each week to help the food pantry gauge what food students want.
- Food preference forms will be available outside the food pantry with a drop off box.

Further Info:

- Students will be encouraged to participate in an anonymous, post-use survey that will allow the Food Pantry to know what students like, don't like, and want to see more of.
